23	governmental entity and whose employment involves the functions listed in this subsection.
25	Further amend the bill in that part designated "§2174-A." by
27	striking out all of subsection 2 (page 1, lines 15 to 22 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

31	'2. Public works employees. No insurer may increase the premium for a personal insurance policy providing motor vehicle liability or collision insurance to a public works employee on
33	the basis of one or more accidents involving a motor vehicle operated by that employee if:

5	This amendment modifies the bill so that an insurance company may not surcharge the personal automobile policy of a

9	vehicle insured separately in the course and scope of employment.
