An Act to Prohibit the Use of All-terrain Vehicles in State Parks.



1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3 12 MRSA §7857, sub-§23-A is enacted to read:

5 23-A. Operating an ATV in a state park. A person is guilty
7 of operating an ATV in a state park if that person operates an
9 ATV on any land managed by the Department of Conservation, Bureau
11 of Parks and Recreation.

11 STATEMENT OF FACT

13 This bill adds state parks to the list of areas where the
operation of all-terrain vehicles (ATV's) is prohibited.
