An Act to Amend the Muzzle-loading Hunting Season.



1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	12 MRSA §7107-A, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 320, § is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

7	4. Open season. There shall be special muzzle-loading open seasons on deer on:
9 11	A. The 7 hunting days preceding the beginning of the regular deer season; and
тт	B. The first 6 hunting days after the regular deer hunting

15	The commissioner may terminate an open season at any time, in any area, if, in the commissioner's opinion, an immediate emergency

21	STATEMENT OF FACT
23	Currently, there is a special muzzle-loading open season or deer on the first 6 hunting days after the regular deer hunting
25	season. This bill permits muzzle-loading hunting of deer during
27	the 7 days prior to the beginning of the regular deer hunting season.
