An Act to Provide Grants to School Administrative Units.



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §15607, sub-§13 is enacted to read:**

5 13. Appropriation for \$50 grant. Appropriate the required
7 funds for the grant provided by section 15612, subsection 11.

9 **Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §15612, sub-§11 is enacted to read:**

11 11. Fifty dollar grant. Effective fiscal year 1989-90,
13 each school administrative unit shall receive a grant each year
15 in an amount equal to \$50 multiplied by the average total
17 resident pupils educated at public expense on the October 1st and
19 April 1st of the year prior to the year of payment. Grants shall
21 be paid in equal monthly installments at the same time as the
23 state subsidy payments are made to the units.

20 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

21 **This bill is to provide each school administrative unit a**
23 **grant of \$50 per pupil educated at public expense by the unit.**
