COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 522, L.D. 707, Bill, "An Act to Make Allocations for the Administrative Expenses of the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages, Department of Finance, for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1990 and June 30, 1991"

Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of the 11th line (page 1, line 35 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Positions - Legislative Count	(251.0)	(251.0)
Positions - Other Count	(9.5)	(9.5)'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 5 and before the emergency clause the following:

'Sec. 6. Feasibility study. The Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages shall conduct a study on the feasibility of placing a state liquor store on land adjacent to the Maine Turnpike. The director of the bureau shall submit a report, including any necessary implementing legislation, to the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriation and Financial Affairs by December 1, 1989.'

Further amend the bill in the fiscal note by inserting at the end the following paragraph:

'The costs associated with the feasibility study in section 6 of this Act shall be absorbed within existing resources.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment corrects the position counts and requires the Director of the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages to conduct a feasibility study on locating a state liquor store adjacent to the Maine Turnpike.
