An Act Pertaining to the Placing of Bear Bait.

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	12 MRSA §7451, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1987, c. 696, §9, is further amended to read:
5	
7	Placing of bear bait. Placing of bear bait shall be in conformity with the following provisions.
9	A. Bait may not be used to hunt black bear, unless <u>the</u> <u>person placing a bear bait holds a current resident hunting</u>
11	<u>license or guide license or is a licensed nonresident</u> <u>hunting with a licensed guide and</u> :

15	(1) The bait is placed at least 50 yards from any travel way that is accessible by a conventional 2-wheel
17	or 4-wheel drive vehicle;
± /	(2) The stand, blind and bait area are tagged by a
19	2-inch by 4-inch tag with the name and address of the baiter;

23	(3) The bait is placed more than 500 yards from any dump or campground;
25	(4) The bait is placed more than 500 yards from an occupied dwelling, unless written permission is granted
27	by the owner or leasee;
29	(5) The bait is placed not more than 30 days before the opening day of the season <u>and not after October</u>
31	<u>31st</u> ;
33	(6) The bait areas will be cleaned up by November 10, as defined by the state litter laws; and

37	(7) The person hunting from any stand or blind of another person has permission of the owner of that stand or blind.
