HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 550,  
L.D. 747, "Resolve, Establishing a Commission to Study the Level  
of Care of Maine's Elderly Citizens"

Amend the amendment in section 1 by inserting after  
subsection 1 the following:

'2. The need for improved individualized treatment planning  
procedures for long-term care clients which can be used to  
identify the gaps between client needs and available services and  
which are based upon principles of maximum feasible restoration  
of functional capacity in the least restrictive setting;'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 by renumbering the  
subsections to read consecutively.

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment adds a provision requiring the study  
commission to evaluate the need for improved long-term care  
planning procedures.
