Amend the amendment in section 2 in subsection 2 in the 3rd and 4th lines (page 2, lines 26 and 27 in the amendment) by striking out the following: "the Department of Human Services,"

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in subsection 3 in the last line (page 2, line 34 in the amendment) by striking out the following: "and"

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in subsection 4 in the last line (page 2, line 39 in the amendment) by striking out the following: "be it further"


Further amend the amendment in section 2 by inserting after subsection 4 the following:

'5. One representative of the Department of Human Services, appointed by the commissioner; and be it further'
