SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 550, L.D. 747, "Resolve, Establishing a Commission to Study the Level of Care of Maine's Elderly Citizens"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in subsection 2 in the 3rd and 4th lines (page 2, lines 26 and 27 in amendment) by striking out the following: "the Department of Human Services," and in the 6th line (page 2, line 29 in L.D.) by striking out the following: ", an area agency on aging"

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in subsection 3 in the last line (page 2, line 34 in amendment) by striking out the following: "and"

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in subsection 4 in the last line (page 2, line 39 in amendment) by striking out the following: "and be it further"

Further amend the amendment in section 2 by inserting after subsection 4 the following:

'5. One representative of the Department of Human Services, appointed by the commissioner; and

6. One representative of area agencies on aging to be appointed jointly by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives; and be it further'


Further amend the amendment in section 3 in the 3rd line (page 2, line 43 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "from among the" the following: 'legislative'

Further amend the amendment in section 5 in the 2nd line (page 3, line 3 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "Legislative Council" the following: ', except that the Legislative Council shall not provide staff assistance during the Second Regular Session of the 114th Legislature'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify that the representative from the Department of Human Services shall be appointed by the commissioner. The amendment also clarifies the appointment procedure for the representative of the area agencies on aging. Finally, the amendment makes it clear that legislative staff provided to the commission by the Legislative Council are available only during legislative interims and not while the Legislature is in session.
