SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 550, L.D. 747

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify that the 7 representative from the Department of Human Services shall be appointed by the commissioner. The amendment also clarifies the 9 appointment procedure for the representative of the area agencies on aging. Finally, the amendment makes it clear that legislative 11 staff provided to the commission by the Legislative Council are available only during legislative interims and not while the 13 Legislature is in session.
