SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 286, L.D. 750, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Laws Relating to the Maine Insurance Guaranty Association and the Maine Self-insurance Guarantee Association"

Amend the amendment in section 16 by striking out all of subsections 3 and 4 and inserting in their place the following:


'3. Staff assistance and funding. The committee shall request funding, staffing and clerical assistance from the Legislative Council. The Bureau of Insurance, the Maine Insurance Guaranty Association, the Maine Life and Health Insurance Guaranty Association and the Maine Self-insurance Guarantee Association shall provide information and assistance as needed to the committee.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 17.

Further amend the amendment in the fiscal note by striking out all of the last sentence.

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

The amendment deletes the appropriation section and provides that the Legislative Council will determine staffing and funding for the legislative study.
