17	(page 1, lines 42 to 45 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

## STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment clarifies that the 3rd Monday in August deadline for replacement of withdrawn candidates does not apply in regard to candidates who withdraw or are withdrawn due to serious illness or death. The amendment allows a political committee to replace these candidates as soon as practicable after the death or withdrawal due to debilitating illness. The amendment also adds a fiscal note.
