SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 559, L.D. 757, Bill, "An Act Concerning Withdrawal of Candidates"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of subsection 2 (page 1, lines 42 to 45 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'2. Deadline for replacement of nominee. A political committee may make a replacement nomination:

A. No later than 5 p.m. of the 2nd Monday in September preceding the general election for a candidate who has withdrawn in accordance with subsection 1, paragraph A; or

B. As soon as practicable for a candidate who withdraws or is withdrawn in accordance with subsection 1, paragraph B or C.'

Further amend the amendment by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 4. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
