An Act to Prohibit Children Aged 10 and Under from Trapping.



1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

37	STATEMENT OF FACT
39	This bill revises certain laws governing trapping by persons under 16 years of age. Currently, persons under 10 years of age
41	are permitted to trap without a license. Sections 1 to 5 repeal that provision of law, and permit trapping by persons under 10
43	years of age only when accompanied at all times while trapping by a licensed adult trapper. Section 6 requires that persons who

are over 10 years of age and under 16 years of age who hold a junior trapping license be accompanied at all times while

trapping by a licensed adult trapper.
