IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Protect Maine's Job Opportunity Zones.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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38 MRSA §1482, sub-§5 is enacted to read:

 5 <u>5. Location restriction.</u> The location of a low-level radioactive waste disposal facility within the State must not be
7 within 30 miles of any border of any zone established under the Job Opportunity Zones Act, Title 5, chapter 403.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill prohibits the development of a low-level radioactive waste disposal facility within 30 miles of a job
opportunity zone, Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 403. This helps protect economically disadvantaged communities from
further economic damage by the location of such a facility in or near these communities.
