25	Whereas, the Legislature desires to extend recognition to the surviving spouses of prisoners of war; and
27	Whereas, under present law the surviving spouse must return any special plates upon the death of a former prisoner of war.

1	shall issue a registration certificate and set of special designating plates to be used in lieu of regular registration
3	plates to any person who served in the United States Armed Forces and who was a prisoner of war at any time during his tenure of
5	service, or the surviving spouse of that person, when that application is accompanied by a copy of the appropriate military
7	form certifying that the person is a former prisoner of war. This special license plate is issued specifically to former prisoners
9	of war <u>and their spouses</u> and the privilege of using the special plate is net transferable <u>only to the former prisoner's spouse</u> .
11	Upon the death of the former prisoner of war, the surviving spouse may retain and display the special license plate. Upon
13	remarriage, the surviving spouse may not use the special license plate on a motor vehicle, but may retain it as a keepsake. Upon
15	the death of the surviving spouse, the family may retain the special license plate, but not use it on a motor vehicle.
17	Sec. 2. Notification to surviving spouse. The Division of Motor
19	Vehicles shall notify the surviving spouse of any former prisoner of war who previously held special registration plates that the
21	surviving spouse may obtain special registration plates in accordance with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 29, section

33	This bill will result in a negligible loss of Highway Fund revenue which can be absorbed within existing resources.'

3 7	STATEMENT OF FACT
39	This amendment retains the intent of the bill to extend the
41	privilege of free special license plates to the surviving spouse of a former prisoner of war. Upon the death or remarriage of the
43	surviving spouse, those special license plates may be retained by the family, but not used on a motor vehicle. The amendment also adds an emergency preamble, emergency clause and fiscal note to
45	the bill.
