NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Clarify the Common Boundary of the Town of Cape Elizabeth and the Town of Scarborough.



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **Boundary line between the Town of Cape Elizabeth and the Town of**
4 **Scarborough.** The boundary line between the Town of Cape
5 Elizabeth and the Town of Scarborough in the County of Cumberland
6 shall commence at a granite monument at the intersection of the
7 municipal boundary lines of Scarborough, South Portland and Cape
8 Elizabeth, the monument being South 55° 06' 50" East a distance
9 of 2210.11 feet from a granite monument on the Westerly side of
10 Highland Avenue as shown on "Plan of Survey for Scarborough-South
11 Portland Town Line" recorded in the Cumberland County Registry of
12 Deeds in Plan Book 133, page 67.

13 Thence South 55° 06' 50" East 2174.42 feet to a granite
14 monument set on the town line between Cape Elizabeth and
15 Scarborough marked C.E.-SC.;

16 Thence South 55° 06' 50" East a distance of 192 feet more or
17 less, to the center line of the Spurwink River;

18 Thence in a general Southeasterly direction by the center
19 line of the Spurwink River;

20 Thence in a general Southwesterly direction by the center
21 line of the Spurwink River as it flows to the Atlantic Ocean at
22 Higgins Beach.
