17	Amend the bill in that part designated " <u>\$5205.</u> " in the 3rd line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by striking the word " <u>State</u> " and inserting in its place the word ' <u>bureau</u> '

21	Further amend the bill in that part designated "§5205." by
23	adding at the end the following: ' <u>The department may first apply</u> to the cost of burial any funds that are available as part of a mortuary trust or any other funds of the ward remaining at the time of the ward's death which are available for this purpose.'

27	Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:
29	
31	'FISCAL NOTE
33	The Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation has indicated that the additonal costs generated as a result of this proposed legislation would be minimal and could be absorbed within existing resources.'

37	
39	STATEMENT OF FACT
41	This amendment permits the department to use mortuary trusts
43	or other available funds of the ward for burial expenses and adds a fiscal note.
