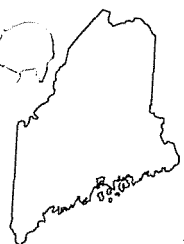

**Authority to convey. Resolved:** That the State Director of the Bureau of Public Lands is authorized to convey to Arthur A. Tukey and Louise H. Tukey, the State's 1/9 interest in a certain parcel of land in Bristol, as described in Exhibit A attached and incorporated in this resolve.

PROPERTY DESCRIPTION  
EXHIBIT A

A certain lot or parcel of land with the buildings thereon situated at Chamberlain in the Town of Bristol, Lincoln County and State of Maine, bounded and described as follows:

South by the north bound of Nelson Shaw and Kenneth Black, the natural bound being the smelt brook, so-called, and being the former residence of Pat Tukey.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve authorizes the Director of the Bureau of Public Lands to transfer land in Bristol to Arthur A. Tukey and Louise H. Tukey.
