IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Establish the Boundary Line between the Town of Falmouth and the City of Westbrook.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

1

3 . Boundary line between the Town of Falmouth and the City of The boundary between the Town of Falmouth in the 5 County of Cumberland and the City of Westbrook in the County of Cumberland shall commence at a granite monument marked with the 7 letters "W" and "F" on the easterly line of the Town of Windham, which monument is one hundred seventy-five feet (175'), more or 9 less, northerly along said Windham line from the center line of U.S. Route 302, and which monument is further identified with 11 reference to the Maine Coordinate System of 1983 (West Zone) as being at coordinates X = 884,344,415, Y = 102,241,236; thence 13 South fifty-five degrees, twenty-six minutes, zero seconds East (S-55°, 26' 00" E) crossing the southerly end of Highland Lake, so called, a distance of two thousand four hundred fifty-eight 15 and eight tenths feet (2,458.8') to a granite monument; thence North two degrees, zero minutes, thirty seconds West (N 2° 00' 17 30" W) a distance of eight hundred seventy-four and one tenths 19 feet (874.1') to a granite monument; thence North seventy-one degrees, twenty-two minutes, zero seconds East (N 71° 22' 00" E) 21 a distance of five hundred twenty-nine and zero tenths feet (529.0') to a granite monument; thence South nineteen degrees, fourteen minutes, thirty seconds East (S 19° 14' 30" E) a 23 distance of seven hundred twenty-three and eight tenths feet 25 (723.8') to a granite monument; thence South sixty-eight degrees, thirteen minutes, zero seconds West (S 68° 13' 00" W) a distance of ninety-three and two tenths feet (93.2') to a granite monument; thence South eighteen degrees, fifty-eight 27 29 minutes, zero seconds East (S 18° 58' 00" E) a distance of eight hundred fifty-eight and zero tenths feet (858.0') to a granite monument; thence North seventy degrees, twenty-eight minutes, thirty seconds East (N 70° 28' 30" E) a distance of seven 31 hundred thirteen and two tenths feet (713.2') to a granite 33 monument on the westerly side of Mast Road, so called; thence 35 North thirty-four degrees, twenty-eight minutes, zero seconds West (N 34°, 28' 00" W) a distance of two hundred twenty-eight 37 zero tenths feet (228.0') to a point; thence North fifty-nine degrees, four minutes, zero seconds East (N 59° 04' 39 00" E) a distance of thirty-five and zero tenths feet (35.0') to a granite monument on the easterly side of said Mast Road; 41 thence North thirty-five degrees, thirty-three minutes, zero seconds West (N 35° 33' 00" W) a distance of two hundred 43 thirty-seven and nine tenths feet (237.9') to a granite monument on the easterly shoulder of said Mast Road; thence North 45 seventy-four degrees, seven minutes, thirty seconds East, (N 74° 7' 30" E) passing through the iron rod set as an intermediate 47 monument shown by the plan hereinafter referenced, a distance of one thousand thirty and two tenths feet (1,030.2') to a granite monument; thence South eight degrees, fifty-eight minutes, 49 thirty seconds West (S 8° 58' 30" W) a distance of one hundred fifty-two and seven tenths feet (152.7') to a granite monument; 51 thence South eighty-seven degrees, four minutes, thirty seconds

East (S 87° 4' 30" E) a distance of nine hundred eighty-five and 1 three tenths feet (985.3') to a granite monument; thence North twenty-seven degrees, forty minutes, zero seconds East (N 27° 3 40' 00" E) a distance of nine hundred fifty-two and five tenths 5 feet (952.5') to a one and one-half inch diameter iron pin set in a boulder; thence South seventy degrees, seventeen minutes, 7 zero seconds East (S 70° 17' 00" E) a distance of seven hundred thirty-seven and two tenths feet (737.2') to a granite monument; 9 thence South thirteen degrees, forty three minutes, zero seconds West (S 13° 43' 00" W) a distance of one thousand twenty-two and two tenths feet (1,022.2') to a granite monument; thence South 11 eighty-nine degrees, eleven minutes, zero seconds East (S 89° 11' 00" E) a distance of six hundred fifty-nine and eight tenths 13 (659.8') to a granite monument; thence South twenty 15 degrees, eight minutes, thirty seconds East (S 20° 8' 30" E) passing through an intermediate monument as shown on the plan 17 hereinafter referenced, a distance of two thousand two hundred ninety-one and zero tenths feet (2,291.0') to a granite 19 monument; thence South seventy-two degrees, fifty-six minutes, zero seconds West (S 72° 56' 00" W) a distance of three hundred fifty-six and zero tenths feet (356.0') to a granite monument; 21 thence North sixty-four degrees, thirty-eight minutes, seconds West (N 64° 38' 00" W) a distance of five hundred 23 thirty-five and nine tenths feet (535.9') to a granite monument; ---25 thence South thirty degrees, thirty-one minutes, zero seconds West (S 30° 31' 00" W) a distance of one thousand two hundred 27 fifty-three and six tenths feet (1,253.6') to a granite monument; thence South fifty-three degrees, eleven minutes, thirty seconds East (S 53° 11' 30" E) a distance of three 29 hundred twenty-seven and six tenths feet (327.6') to a granite 31 monument on the generally southerly side of Gowen Road, so called; thence South fifty-three degrees, twenty-three minutes, thirty seconds East (S 53° 23' 30" E) passing through an 33 intermediate monument shown on the plan hereinafter referenced, 35 a distance of one thousand eight hundred sixty-two and nine tenths feet (1,862.9') to a granite monument; thence North 37 twenty-nine degrees, fifty-one minutes, thirty seconds East (N 29° 51' 30" E), a distance of sixty-five and seven tenths feet (65.7') to a granite monument; thence South fifty-three degrees, 39 ten minutes, thirty seconds East (S 53° 10' 30" E) a distance of 41 one thousand one hundred fifty-eight and seven tenths feet (1,158.7') to a two inch diameter aluminum pipe monument set; thence South thirty-seven degrees, thirty minutes, zero seconds 43 West (S 37° 30' 00" W) a distance of five hundred sixty-one and 45 zero tenths feet (561.0') to a granite monument; thence South fifty-two degrees, thirty minutes, thirty seconds East (S 52° 47 30' 30" E) a distance of six hundred twelve and zero tenths feet a granite monument; thence South thirty-four (612.0') to 49 degrees, thirty-five minutes, thirty seconds West (S 34° 35' 30". W) a distance of three hundred thirty-one and three tenths feet 51 (331.3') to a granite monument; thence South thirty-four degrees, forty-one minutes, thirty seconds East (S 34° 41' 30"

- E) passing through the intermediate monument shown on the plan hereinafter referenced, a distance of one thousand eight hundred 3 forty-nine and zero tenths feet (1,849.0') to a granite monument; thence North eighty-four degrees, twenty-four minutes, thirty seconds East (N 84° 24' 30" E) a distance of eight 5 hundred sixty-two and two tenths feet (862.2') to a granite monument; thence South thirty-five degrees, twenty-nine minutes, zero seconds East (S 35° 29' 00" E) a distance of seven hundred forty and eight tenths feet (740.8') to a granite monument; 9 thence North twenty-two degrees, seventeen minutes, thirty seconds East (N 22° 17' 30" E) a distance of two hundred 11 thirty-six and five tenths feet (236.5') to a granite monument; thence South thirty-five degrees, thirty-two minutes, thirty 13 seconds East (S 35° 32' 30" E) a distance of nine hundred 15 forty-eight and eight tenths feet (948.8') to a granite monument on the northerly side of Brook Street, so called; thence South thirty-five degrees, thirty-five minutes, zero seconds East (S 17 35° 35' 00" E) passing through the intermediate monument shown 19 by the plan hereinafter referenced, a distance of two thousand three hundred sixty and three tenths feet (2,360.3') to a 21 granite monument on the northerly bank of the Presumpscot River; thence continuing on the same course to the thread of said River 23 which is the northerly line of the City of Portland.
- Bearings referenced herein are oriented to the Maine Coordinate System of 1983 (West Zone) as determined by a survey of the within described boundary by Plisga and Day, land surveyors. The within described boundary being the same shown on a plan titled, "Survey Plan Showing Location of Municipal Boundary Between the Town of Falmouth and the City of Westbrook, Cumberland County Maine" dated February 16, 1988, to be recorded in the Cumberland County Registry of Deeds.

The purpose of this bill is to define and describe the location of the boundary between the Town of Falmouth and the City of Westbrook.
