Resolve, to Require the Classification of Certain Great Ponds in the State.



Great Pond classification. Resolved: That the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, in conjunction with the Department of Conservation, shall by rule provide that the Great Ponds in the State of Maine be classified according to the recreational uses and opportunities on and in those bodies of water; and be it further

Report required. Resolved: That the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall make a report, including any necessary implementing legislation, to the Second Regular Session

of the 114th Legislature by December 1, 1989. This report shall include the classifications required by this resolve and any

recommendations determined necessary by the department.
