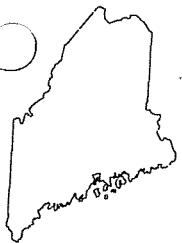

An Act to Expand the Retired Senior Volunteer Programs, Foster Grandparent Programs and Senior Companion Program.



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated from the
5 General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

the State. Funds for fiscal
year 1990-91 represent a 5%
increase from those provided
for in fiscal year 1989-90.
