
SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 609, L.D. 833, Bill, "An Act Relating to Drug Testing"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "§683." in subsection 1, in paragraph B in the 2nd line (page 5, line 2 in the amendment) by striking out the underlined words "Human Services" and inserting in their place the following: 'Administration' and in the 3rd line (page 5, line 3 in the amendment) by striking out the underlined word and figure "section 687" and inserting in their place the following: 'the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, Title 5, chapter 375'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment transfers the rule-making authority concerning employers' employee assistance programs from the Department of Human Services to the Department of Administration, since the Department of Administration has greater familiarity with those programs.
