An Act to Include Certain Proprietary Schools in Eligibility Requirements of the Maine Educational Loan Authority's Supplemental Loan Program.

(EMERGENCY)



1	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
3	as emergencies; and
5	Whereas, students who are residents of the State attending institutions of higher education and the families of these
7	students are in need of financial assistance; and
9	Whereas, it is desirable for the State to make available programs of the Maine Educational Loan Authority to Maine schools
11	not previously eligible; and
13	Whereas, students need these programs to finance their educational studies as early as possible in 1989; and
15	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
17	create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
19	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,
21	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
23	20-A MRSA §11413, sub-§11, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 807,
25	§3, is amended to read:
27	11. Institution. "Institution" or "institution of higher education" means any public or private nemprefit educational
29	institution within the State, or such-an any public or private nonprofit institution outside of the State which is attended by
31	residents of the State, which:
33	A. Provides a program of education beyond the high school level;
35	B. Awards an associate, bachelor or advanced degree; and

39	C. Meets the conditions of applicable rules.
41	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.

45	STATEMENT OF FACT
47	This bill allows the Maine Educational Loan Authority to
±/	expand its supplemental loan program to include students at
49	certain Maine proprietary schools such as Andover College, Beal College, Casco Bay College and Mid-State College. Presently,
51	students at these schools are ineligible for such loans.
