1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated from the  
5 General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

13 All Other \$30,000

15 Provides funds for the purchase of computer

23 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

25 This bill provides \$30,000 to the Department of Human  
27 Services, Division of Eye Care . The money will be used to  
purchase computer hardware and software that can be used to  
29 assist blind and visually impaired people seeking computer  
training and assistance. The training of blind and visually  
impaired people in the use of computers will enable them to find  
31 employment and to contribute to the growth and development of the  
state economy.
