An Act to Provide the Division of Eye Care With Computer Technology.



1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

9	Bureau of Rehabilitation
11	Division of Eye Care
13	All Other \$30,000
15	Provides funds for the purchase of computer
17	hardware and software. Unexpended money shall not lapse but shall be carried forward

23	STATEMENT OF FACT
25	This bill provides \$30,000 to the Department of Human Services, Division of Eye Care . The money will be used to
27	purchase computer hardware and software that can be used to assist blind and visually impaired people seeking computer
29	training and assistance. The training of blind and visually impaired people in the use of computers will enable them to find
31	employment and to contribute to the growth and development of the

state economy.
