COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 622, L.D. 845, Bill, "An Act to Fund Community-based AIDS Programs and Services"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
