An Act to Provide Case Management Services for Children in Need of Treatment.

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 Council, in its report to the Legislature on possible expansion in use of Medicaid funding, has identified several roadblocks in its effort to utilize Medicaid to its fullest. Principally, the council noted the lack of seed money and staff time to make the necessary plan and rule changes.

Case management has been identified as a critical unmet need by the Commission to Examine the Quality, Quantity and
Availability of Services for Children with Special Needs, Concannon Commission, and the draft report of the Commission on
Children in Need of Supervision and Treatment. Also recent news articles on children in state care and custody have pointed to
case management as a missing piece in the development of intensive foster home and group care options for children.

This appropriation provides for matching funds to establish 17 a Medicaid case management program and the necessary staff support to do Medicaid plan and rule changes. Staff support 19 would also examine how to make use of existing expenditures for Medicaid match.

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
