HOUSE AMENDMENT "^A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 330, L.D. 867, Bill, "An Act to Facilitate the Disclosure of Information in Medical Support Recoupment and Child Support Cases"

Amend the amendment in that part designated "§3755-A." in subsection 2 in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 2, lines 2 and 3 in amendment) by striking out the following: "and notwithstanding any other law or any claim or assertion of confidentiality,"

Further amend the amendment in that part designated "§3755-A." in subsection 3 in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 2, lines 29 and 30 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Notwithstanding any other law or any claim or assertion of confidentiality, the" and inserting in its place the following: 'The'

Further amend the amendment in that part designated "§3755-A." in subsection 6 in the 3rd line (page 3, line 15 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "department" the following: ', to the extent it is not confidential or privileged,'

Further amend the amendment in that part designated "§3755-A." by inserting after subsection 8 the following:

'9. Notice. At the time that the department makes a request or demand, it shall notify the responsible parent or alleged responsible parent in the manner set forth in subsection 4.'

Further amend the amendment in that part designated "§3755-A." in subsection 9 in the first line (page 3, line 27 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Failure" and inserting in its place the following: 'Knowing failure'

Further amend the amendment in that part designated "§3755-A." by renumbering the subsections to read consecutively.
