An Act Regarding Traveling Barbers.



1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	32 MRSA §1552, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1987, c. 395, Pt. A, §146, is further amended to read:

7	2. Exceptions. The practice of cosmetology shall be carried on only by persons duly licensed to practice in this State and only in a licensed beauty shop, except as provided in this
9	subsection. A duly licensed cosmetologist may, when charging the usual fees, practice cosmetology:
11	A. Upen On patients in hospitals or nursing homes;

15	B. Upen On residents of summer camps;
17	C. Upen On inmates or residents of institutions of the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation and the Department of Corrections;
19	bepartment of Corrections;
21	D. Upen <u>On</u> an invalid or handicapped person in that person's place of residence;
23	E. Upen $\underline{On}$ a resident of a nursing home;
25	F. Upen $\underline{On}$ a hotel or motel occupant in that person's hotel or motel room; and

29	G. Upen <u>On</u> a person in the person's residence,—when—done for—the—usual—fees, <u>; or</u>
31	H. On persons in their private businesses.

37	The bill allows beauticians to practice cosmetology on persons in private businesses.
