17	Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the title and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place
19	the following:
21	'Amend the amendment by inserting after the enacting clause the following:
23	'Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §559, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 240, §1, is
25	repealed.'
27	Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated " $562-A_{-}$ " by striking out all of subsection 2 and inserting in
29	its place the following:
31	'2. Violation notices. The department shall issue notices to growers, manufacturers or sellers alleged to have violated any
33	provision of this subchapter. Any person who violates this subchapter commits a civil violation for which a forfeiture not
35	to exceed \$1,000 may be adjudged. The department may also
37	recover costs of investigation, with the limitation that the total forfeiture assessed for a violation shall not exceed \$1,000.'

41	Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:
43	' Sec. 3. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

FISCAL NOTE

17 Enactment of this legislation would require a one-time General Fund appropriation to the Department of Agriculture, Food 19 Rural Resources (Public Services-Agriculture, and Account #01101.6) in the amount of \$2,000 for fiscal year 1989-90. This 21 appropriation would provide funds for anticipated costs of rule-making hearings. Also, this bill could result, in an 23 increase in Other Special Revenue to the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources due to the proposed civil 25 violation. However, the exact increase in dedicated revenue from collection of civil penalties, as well as required the 27 allocation, cannot be determined at this time.'

29 Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment retains the intent of the committee amendment and corrects provisions of the bill that gave the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources the ability to determine and impose fines for a civil violation.
