**An Act to Create a Standard for Respiratory Rescue Personnel Who
Are State Employees.**



1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3 5 MRSA §19-A is enacted to read:

5 §19-A. Protective equipment training for state employees

7 If protective equipment, such as that issued to fire
9 fighters in Title 26, section 2103, is issued or made available
11 to any state employee that employee must receive training in the
13 use of the equipment before being required or asked to use it.
15 Training must be provided on at least an annual basis and
otherwise meet or exceed the requirements of the General
Industry Standards of the Occupational Safety and Health
Administration, 29 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 1910,
Subpart L.

STATEMENT OF FACT

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21 This bill requires a state employee to receive proper
23 training in the use of protective equipment issued or made
25 available to that employee before the employee must use the
equipment. Training must be held on at least an annual basis and
meet Occupational Safety and Health Administration standards.
