director is also responsible
for advocacy on behalf of
community hospices throughout
the State.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill requests funding to employ one executive director and one part-time secretary for coordinating the services of the Maine Hospice Council and their affiliates. There are currently 23 community hospices throughout the State.

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
