COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 656, L.D. 890, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Definition of Teacher in the Laws Relating to the Maine State Retirement System"

Amend the bill by inserting before the emergency clause the following:

'Sec. 6. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Further amend the bill in the Emergency clause in the last line (page 5, line 11 in L.D.) by striking out the words "when approved" and inserting in their place the following: 'July 1, 1989'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

This bill increases the unfunded actuarial reserve or unfunded liability by approximately \$175,000. The amortization or reduction of this unfunded actuarial reserve requires additional General Fund appropriations to teachers' retirement of \$8,000 in fiscal year 1989-90, \$8,480 in fiscal year 1990-91, and increasing amounts at 6% annually thereafter.'

This amendment changes the effective date of this emergency legislation to July 1, 1989. It adds an appropriation section from the General Fund to the teachers' retirement account to fund the requirements of the bill.
