### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Extend the Eligibility of Retired Teachers for Group Health Insurance.



#### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §13451, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 450, §§2 and 3, is amended to read:

1. Eligibility; retired teacher members. Any retired teacher who receives a retirement benefit from the Maine State Retirement System shall be eligible for group accident and sickness or health insurance, provided that the retired teacher also-meets-the-eligibility-requirements-for-participation-imposed by-the-group-plan-that-governed-the-teacher-last-as-an-active teacher-and participated in the plan for one year immediately prior to retirement or October 1, 1987,-whichever-comes-last. Retired teachers may not be required to maintain a dues paying membership in any organization as a requirement for participation in a group health insurance plan under this subsection. The rate for the insurance coverage shall be the same as the rate provided for active teachers in that school system.

### Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §13451, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

4. School units which change plans. If a school unit changes its group health insurance plan or provider, the school unit at the time that it transfers active teachers to the new plan or provider shall inform all retired teachers who participate in the group accident and health insurance plan through prior employment with that school unit of the change, detailing the provisions of both the old and new plans. Any retired teacher eligible under this subsection, within 90 days of notification of the change, may request to be transferred to the new plan or provider.

Sec. 3. 20-A MRSA §13461, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 324, is repealed.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill clarifies confusion in the law that was created by the passage in 1987 of 2 overlapping bills dealing with group health insurance for retired teachers.

The 2 differences between them are that the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 13451 requires that to be eligible for group insurance retired teachers must meet the eligibility requirements of the health plan in effect at the time of their retirement and limits the State's contribution to the retired teachers' pension to be 15%. (It is 100% for retired state employees.) Title 20-A, section 13461 has neither of these provisions.

This bill amends Title 20-A, section 13451 to eliminate the requirement that the retired teacher be eligible under the provisions of the plan in effect when the teacher retired and continues the 15% contribution provision. It repeals Title 20-A, section 13461.
