16	Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:
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20	'An Act Regarding the Maine Technical College System'
22	Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:
24	'Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §12703-A is enacted to read:
26	<u>\$12703-A. Comprehensive plan</u>
28	Beginning in 1991, the board of trustees shall develop a
30	comprehensive · 5-year plan for the Maine Technical College System. The plan is a statement of strategies and specific
32	actions designed to achieve the academic, occupational and technical educational mission of the system. The plan is a
34	working document with annual updates, as needed, to address interim issues identified during the life of the plan. At a
36	minimum the plan must include a complete statement of the goals of the system, individual campus goals, program objectives and
38	plans and a statement of financial needs to implement the plan. Each succeeding plan must include an assessment of the system's
40	success in implementing the plan. The board shall thoroughly review and revise the plan every 5 years. In developing,
42	updating and revising the plan, the board shall provide for input from the educational community, the business and industry
44	community, the labor community, the dusiness and industry community, the labor community, the general public and the technical college faculty and staff.

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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 660, L.D. 902

Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §12705, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1989, c. 502, Pt. A, §62, is repealed and the following enacted in its 2 place: 4 Membership. The board of trustees consists of 11 1. 6 appointed voting members and one ex officio voting member, as follows: 8 Eleven from the field of business and industry, the Α. 10 field of labor, the field of education and the general public; and 12 B. The Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services, or the commissioner's successor, who serves as the ex 14 officio voting member. 16 Sec. 3. Transition. The current member of the board of trustees representing the State Board of Education and the 18 current member of the board of trustees representing the University of Maine System remain voting members of the Board of 20 Trustees of the Maine Technical College System until their 22 respective terms expire. 24 **FISCAL NOTE** 26 The Technical College System will be able to absorb the cost 28 of this bill within existing resources.' 30 STATEMENT OF FACT 32 , This amendment replaces the original bill. The purpose of 34 the amendment is to change the makeup of the Board of Trustees of the Technical College System and to establish a comprehensive, strategic planning process for the system. The board is directed 36 to develop a series of 5-year plans to be updated on an annual 38 basis as needed and completely revised every 5 years. The plan is to identify specific actions of the system to achieve the academic, employment and technical educational mission of 40 Each 5-year plan is to address overall system system. objectives, individual campus objectives, program plans and 42 financial needs. Each succeeding plan must include an assessment of the success of the previous plan. 44 The makeup of the Board of Trustees of the Technical College 46 System is amended by deleting the Commissioner of Economic and 48 Community Development and the Commissioner of Labor as ex officio members and the representatives of the State Board of Education The current board and and the University of Maine System. 50 university system members will serve out their existing terms. 52 Page 2-LR1133(2) Reported by the Majority of the Committee on Education
