~~Allocations to Maternal and Child Health under the Maternal and Child Health Block Grant include \$20,000 in fiscal year 1988-89 for the Portland Dental Clinic and \$20,000 in fiscal year 1988-89 for the Bangor Dental Clinic. Allocations for these purposes shall be incorporated into future budget preparations.~~ Allocations for the Hartland Health Center shall only be included in future budget preparations if the Department of Human Services determines a need still exists.

Allocations to Maternal and Child Health under the Maternal and Child and Child Health Block Grants include \$16,000 in fiscal year 1989-90 and in fiscal year 1990-91 for each of the following: Chester Dental Clinic, Portland Dental Clinic, Bangor Dental Clinic and the Jessie Albert Memorial Dental Clinic in Bath, Maine. Allocations for these purposes shall be incorporated into future budget preparations.
