COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 670, L.D. 918, Bill, "An Act to Make the Department of Marine Resources Responsible for Coastal Search and Rescue"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 4 (page 2, lines 9 to 25 in L.D.)

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 5 and before the fiscal note the following:

Sec. 6. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

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Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

Further amend the bill by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill would result in a General Fund appropriation to the Department of Marine Resources, Bureau of Marine Patrol, in the amount of \$812,126 for fiscal year 1989-90 and \$764,501 for fiscal year 1990-91. It should be understood that the above mentioned funding is included in separate legislation, L.D. 986, "An Act to Fund the Law Enforcement and Search and Rescue Activities of the Department of Marine Resources." Also, this bill would result in a General Fund appropriation to the Judicial Department in the amount of \$17,435 for fiscal year 1989-90 and \$17,999 for fiscal year 1990-91. This appropriation would provide funds for an assistant clerk position to handle the anticipated additional court filings resulting from the increased enforcement activities of the proposed 15 marine patrol officers.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment deletes the provisions of the bill increasing the boating registration. It also adds an appropriation section and repeals and replaces the fiscal note.
