HOUSE AMENDMENT <sup>A</sup> to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 348,  
L.D. 920, Bill, "An Act to Implement Recommendations Proposed by  
the Blue Ribbon Commission on the Regulation of Health Care  
Expenditures"

Amend the amendment in section 42 by striking out all of  
subsection 2 (page 19, lines 32 to 49 in the amendment) and  
inserting in its place the following:

'2. Composition. The study commission shall be composed of  
13 members. The President of the Senate shall appoint one member  
of the Senate. The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall  
appoint 2 members of the House of Representatives. The Governor  
shall appoint one representative of the Department of Human  
Services, one physician and one representative of a 3rd-party  
payor other than the Department of Human Services. The President  
of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives  
shall jointly appoint one representative of the Maine Health  
Policy Advisory Council. The President of the Senate and the  
Speaker of the House of Representatives shall jointly appoint one  
hospital official and one consumer member, including at least one  
representative of labor. The Governor shall appoint one hospital  
official and 2 consumer members. The chair of the Maine Health  
Care Finance Commission shall appoint one representative of the  
Maine Health Care Finance Commission. All appointments shall be  
made within 30 days of the effective date of this Act. The Chair  
of the Legislative Council shall call the first meeting of the  
commission. The members of the commission shall designate a  
chair from among the members of the study commission.'
