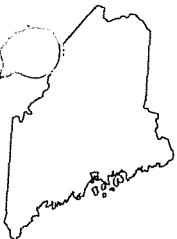

An Act Regarding Damage from Industrial Fallout.



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **38 MRSA §613** is enacted to read:

5 **§613. Damage to private property**

7 If the owner or operator of an air contamination source
9 intends to accept or satisfy claims from members of the general
11 public who allege that their real or personal property has been
13 damaged by emissions, that owner or operator shall notify the
15 public, in a newspaper of general circulation in the location in
17 which the source is situated of the dates on which claims may be
19 filed.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

19

21 This bill requires the owner or operator of an air
contamination source to notify the public of the dates on which
it will accept claims from members of the public who allege that
their property has been damaged by emissions.
