HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 676, L.D. 925, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Laws Relating to Marriage"

Amend the bill in section 4 in that part designated "§62." in subsection 5 in the 6th line (page 2, line 46 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "intentions." and inserting its place the following: 'intentions and'

Further amend the bill in section 4 in that part designated "§62." in subsection 5 in the last line (page 2, line 52 in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "order" the following: 'after notice and opportunity for hearing.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify that notice and opportunity for hearing must be given before a Judge of Probate may refuse to issue a marriage license to a minor.
