13	COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 350, L.D. 927, Bill, "An Act to Establish a Comprehensive Service Delivery System for
15	Persons with Head Injuries"
17	Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause and before section 1 the following:
19	'Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3086, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 494,
21	is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
23	 Head injury. "Head injury" means an insult to the brain resulting directly or indirectly from trauma, anoxia, vascular
25	lesions or infection, which:
27	A. Is not of a degenerative or congenital nature;
29	B. Can produce a diminish or altered state of consciousness resulting in impairment of cognitive abilities or physical
31	functioning:
33	C. Can result in the disturbance of behavioral or emotional functioning;
35	D. Can be either temporary or permanent; and

39	E. Can cause partial or total functional disability or psychosocial maladjustment.'
41	Further amend the bill in section 1 in the appropriation by striking out all of the 7th line (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) and
43	inserting in its place the following:
45	'All Other \$260,000 \$390,000'

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to S.P. 350, L.D. 927 1 Further amend the bill in section 1 in the appropriation by striking out all of the 13th line (page 1, line 22 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: 3 5 'All Other \$150,000 \$160,000' Further amend the bill in section 1 in the appropriation by 7 striking out all of the 18th line (page 1, line 30 in L.D.) and 9 inserting in its place the following: 11 'All Other \$117,000 \$175,000' Further amend the bill in section 1 in the appropriation by 13 striking out all of the last line (page 1, line 38 in L.D.) and 15 inserting in its place the following: **'TOTAL** 17 \$527,000 \$725,000' 19 Further amend the bill in section 2 in the allocation by striking out all of the 7th line (page 1, line 50 in L.D.) and 21 inserting in its place the following: 23 'All Other \$487,000 \$731,000' 25 Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read 27 consecutively. 29 STATEMENT OF FACT 31 This amendment cuts the General Fund appropriation to 33 \$1,252,000 for the upcoming biennium. 35 Under this amendment, it is estimated that each year 79 to 90 Maine citizens with traumatic head injury will receive 37 servcies, as follows: 39 1. Twelve to 14 citizens will be served in small intensive residential rehabilitation programs; 41 2. Forty-five to 50 citizens will receive day rehabilitation services; and 43 45 3. Twenty-two to 26 citizens will receive supported employment services. 47 This amendment also adds a request for funding for room and board for 12 new boarding-care beds for persons with traumatic 49 head injury. 51 Finally, this amendment clarifies the definition of "head 53 injury."
