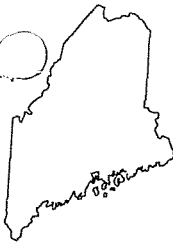

The Meduxnekeag Ramblers Snowmobile Club, Inc.; exempt from sales tax. Resolved: That, notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 36, section 1811, the Meduxnekeag Ramblers Snowmobile Club, Inc. shall be exempt from paying sales tax on the purchase of a \$70,000 snow grooming machine, and shall be exempt from paying taxes on this purchase only.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this resolve is to exempt the Meduxnekeag Ramblers Snowmobile Club, Inc. from paying any sales tax on the purchase of a particular piece of snow grooming equipment. The tax exempt status will be on this purchase only.
