COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 691, L.D. 943, Bill, "An Act to Provide Needed Services Identified by the Task Force on Incapacitated and Dependent Adults, and Required by the United States Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1988"

Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:

'An Act to Provide Needed Services Identified by the Task Force on Incapacitated and Dependent Adults, and Required by the United States Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1987'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

12 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

14 This amendment changes the appropriation section of the bill
16 to reflect the funds needed by the Department of Mental Health
and Mental Retardation and the Department of Human Services and
18 adds the necessary position count for the positions being
authorized. It also changes the number of geriatric mental
20 health resource persons requested for Regions I and III from 3 to
2, allocating the funds originally allocated for a 3rd person for
treatment services in those regions instead.

22 The amendment also changes the reference to the United
24 States Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1988 to the United
States Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1987.
