

SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 693, L.D. 945, Bill, "An Act Making It Illegal to Possess Lobsters Caught Illegally"

Amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "§6443." in the first paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 19 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "lobsters." the following: 'Any trap or other container and the contents in it found in violation of this section may be seized and the contents returned to their natural habitat.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment authorizes marine patrol officers to seize unmarked lobster containers that are in violation of the law and return the lobsters to their natural habitat.
