SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 357, L.D. 958, Bill, "An Act to Enhance the Integrated Pest Management Capabilities of Agriculture in Maine"

Amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

Sec. 3. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Provides funds to develop and refine integrated pest management techniques and expand the availability of integrated pest management programs to more commodities and to more Maine farmers.

FISCAL NOTE

Enactment of this legislation would require a General Fund appropriation to the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources in the amount of \$150,000 for fiscal years 1989-90 and 1990-91. This appropriation would provide funds to develop and refine integrated pest management techniques and expand the availability of integrated pest management programs to more commodities and to more Maine farmers.


