23	STATEMENT OF FACT
25	
27	The primary purpose of the bill is to protect dealers of farm machinery. This amendment will assure that the bill does not impact on those dealers primarily engaged in the sale of
29	heavy construction, industrial and utility equipment, attachments, accessories and repair parts. These dealers are
31	substantially larger than general farm equipment dealers and are better able to negotiate with the suppliers.
