

SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 706, L.D. 967, Bill, "An Act to Establish State Guidelines for Child Support Awards"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "~~§303-A.~~" in subsection 4 in the 5th line (page 2, line 41 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "household." the following: 'Consideration shall be given, however, to the relative periods of time which a child spends with each parent and the relative consequential financial burden this places upon each parent.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment provides that the support guidelines must take into consideration the relative periods of time which a child spends with each parent and the consequential financial burdens.
