STATEMENT OF FACT

Cardiovascular prevention and education services are not routinely available to Maine citizens. A statewide effort to assist communities in establishing such programs is needed. The funds requested in this bill would enable the State to provide training and technical assistance as well as initial program funding for as many as 20 community or regional programs. The types of community organizations which could establish these prevention programs include hospitals, community health agencies, nursing agencies, community action programs, health centers and local health departments. A match of \$1 local funds for every \$1 of state funds will be expected of each program.
