COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 710, L.D. 971, Bill, "An Act to Undedicate the Alcohol Premium Tax Fund"

Amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 7. Transition provision. The Governor shall submit legislation by January 1, 1990, necessary to carry out the intent of this Act with regard to appropriating funds from the General Fund and deallocating funds from the Alcohol Premium Fund account. Encumbered balances as of June 30, 1990, in the Alcohol Premium Fund accounts affected by this Act shall be transferred to appropriate General Fund accounts in fiscal year 1990-91.

Sec. 8. Effective date. Sections 1 to 6 of the bill shall take effect July 1, 1990.

**FISCAL NOTE**

This bill will increase the General Fund revenues as follows:

	1990-91
Increase in General Fund revenues	\$5,832,622

Legislation to appropriate funds to the Department of Corrections, the Department of Educational and Cultural Services, the Department of Human Services and the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation will be presented to the Second Regular Session of the 114th Legislature.'
